

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

CONSTRUCTION OF NEWARK SPRAY IRRIGATION FACILITIES WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND

The Worcester County Commissioners are currently accepting sealed bids for construction of Spray Irrigation Facilities in the Newark Service Area for the Worcester County Department of Public Works - Water and Wastewater Division. The Project generally consists of construction of approximately 6,500 linear feet of discharge piping, spray irrigation piping and discharge sprinkler heads, a new pump station, modification of the treatment plant pond to increase holding, testing, start-up, site restoration and close-out, and includes furnishing all equipment, material, and labor for the work described in the bid document drawings and specifications. This project is funded by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) administered by the Environmental Protection Agency and the Maryland Department of the Environment. Contractor requirements under the CWSRF are included in the bid documents and include, but are not limited to, use of American iron and steel, adhering to applicable Davis Bacon Act prevailing wage rates, and participation of disadvantaged business enterprises. Interested bidders are encouraged to attend a non-mandatory **Pre-Bid Conference at 10:00 AM (EDT) on Tuesday, June 11, 2019** at the Worcester County Department of Public Works - Water and Wastewater Division Office at 1000 Shore Lane, Ocean Pines, Maryland 21811. **Sealed proposals will be accepted until 1:00 PM (EDT) on Monday, July 8, 2019** in the Office of the County Commissioners at Room 1103 - Worcester County Government Center, One West Market Street, Snow Hill, Maryland 21863, at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud. Envelopes shall be marked "**Bid Enclosed - Newark Spray Irrigation Facilities**" in the lower left-hand corner. After opening, bids will be forwarded to the Public Works Department for tabulation, review and recommendation to the County Commissioners for their consideration at a future meeting. In awarding the bid, the Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids, waive formalities, informalities and technicalities therein, and to take whatever bid they determine to be in the best interest of the County considering lowest or best bid, quality of goods and work, time of delivery or completion, responsibility of bidders being considered, previous experience of bidders with County contracts, or any other factors they deem appropriate.
