<b>NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS AND PLANHOLDERS</b>
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The Proposal Documents for the above-referenced Project are modified as set forth in this Addendum. The original Proposal Documents and any previously issued addenda remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Addendum, which is hereby made part of the Proposal Documents. 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<b>1.0 – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS</b>
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The following questions and answers are provided as a matter of information to clarify issues raised about the Proposal Documents.
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Item	Questions and Answers
1.1	Q. Please clarify that electronic proposals are accepted and/or how many copies are required if hand-delivered? A. <b>Electronic proposals are being accepted.</b>
1.2	Q. Is Worcester County providing the front-end specifications? A. <b>Yes, the County will provide the front-end specifications for bidding purposes.</b>
1.3	Q. Please clarify what sediment and erosion controls notes, details, permits will be required? A. <b>Sediment control approvals wouldn't be needed for the dredging work itself as they will be loading directly from hopper barges into water tight trucks for transport and therefore not generating any disturbance onsite. A note should be provided on the plans that specifies that the receiving site has obtained applicable approvals/permits for depositing of dredge spoil. We don't want to include that permitting within this dredging RFP.</b>
1.4	Q. Do you want twenty (2) copies of the final documents? A. <b>We certainly don't need 20 sets of final documents and permits. We would only need 3-5 for our construction permit process (owner, contractor, inspector, file, engineer).</b>
