### 2.0 – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following questions and answers are provided as a matter of information to clarify issues raised about the Bid Documents.

Item	Questions and Answers
2.1	<p>Q. Will the county be able to provide architectural drawings, and/or actual photos, of the space where this batting cage system will be installed? Each system is unique in terms of the hardware that is needed to properly suspend the cage, and further visual information is needed to accurately quote this.</p> <p>A. We are attempting to locate the architectural drawings. Please see the attached photo of where the system will be located.</p>
2.2	<p>Q. For the safety lock, we have a shaft brake or a safety belt for options. Is there a specification for what type you want?</p> <p>A. Just has to have a safety feature(s) that ensures the structure will not free fall. Does not necessarily have exact requirements for what needs to be used.</p>
2.3	<p>Q. For the cage netting itself, do you want the divider to be permanently installed down the middle of the cage so that there are (2) 35'L hitting tunnels at all times? Or, do you want the divider panel to be independently operated so that you have the ability to raise it and create a 70' tunnel?</p> <p>A. Independently operated / removable divider to create the 70' tunnel. We have used a 10 x 10 protective screen down the middle in the past to limit recoil from nets to each hitter on opposing sides when cut to 35' cage, but foul balls can sneak over the top of these large screens.</p>
