The following questions and answers are provided as a matter of information to clarify issues raised about the Bid Documents.

Item	Questions and Answers
2.1	<p>Q. When will the notice to proceed be given to the successful bidder?</p> <p>A. An award recommendation will be submitted to the County Commissioners at the next available meeting after the bid opening. The Commissioners meet on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of every month. Once approved, a notice to proceed will be sent.</p>
2.2	<p>Q. In regards to the divider that is to be provided in the middle of the cage allowing two hitters in opposite directions; what type of material should this divider be? Can this divider be the same #60-gauge nylon netting or should this divider be of some other material (vinyl, vinyl mesh, etc.)?</p> <p>A. Are there recommendation for the type of material that the divider could be that will limit net recoil into opposing hitter? It could be the same 60 cage nylon netting if not other recommendation available.</p>
2.3	<p>Q. Based upon the picture of the desired location provided in addendum #1, is the cage to be centered at the peak of the building? Furthermore, should the;</p> <p>a. Cage span the buildings main frames? b. Attach directly to one main frame? c. Will purlin attachment be acceptable?</p> <p>A. Cage will likely span the buildings main frames (please see attached picture). Unsure at this point if purlins are acceptable for this.</p>
2.4	<p>Q. To ensure bidders are pricing the batting cage in the owner’s desired location, will architectural drawings or marked up pictures that show the cage’s desired location be provided?</p> <p>A. The picture provided in Addendum #1 is attached with mark-ups.</p>

2.5	Q. Can you please confirm that the batting cage will be motorized for raising/lowering? A. Yes, batting cages will be required to be motorized / hands free retractable cage.
2.6	Q. Will the batting cage be operated by a wall-mounted key-switch or by wireless remote/receiver? A. Wall mount key is sufficient
