- BUDGET Jessica Wilson handed out Budget Year 2020 Worksheet Reports. She explained the projected Revenue and Expenses for FY 2019/2020. Enterprise Funds are to be self-supporting, and since the Homeowner Convenience Centers and Recycling are not they are being moved to the General Fund.
- ILLEGAL DUMPING There has been constant illegal dumping of trash in Worcester County and also at the Recycling Centers. The County is in the early stages of forming a campaign to stop illegal dumping. The plan is to educate the public to make them aware that the dumping of trash in the recycling containers, on the side of the road, and on other people's property is illegal. The Sherriff's Department will be giving out citations to anyone dumping illegally. Ocean Pines is in the process of reaching out to the residents and informing them of the law regarding dumping trash at the Recycling Centers.
- MRA TONNAGE REPORT Worcester County's 2018 Recycling Tonnage Rate was 39.93 percent. That is a 6 percent increase from year 2017.
