- **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENT 9/28/19** – The Household Hazardous Waste Event will be held on Saturday, September 28, 2019 from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. This event will be held at Showell Elementary School. Household Hazardous Waste and computers/laptops may be dropped off, but no other electronics will be accepted.
- **KEEP WORCESTER CLEAN CAMPAIGN** – Mike McClung discussed the new anti-littering campaign. Worcester County is launching a Keep Worcester Clean Campaign to control illegal dumping and to also educate the public on recycling and on what is recyclable and what is not. Community events will be held to discuss littering in the County. Mike McClung and Kim Moses went to Ocean Pines to meet with the Public Relations person regarding trash in and around the recycling containers at the recycling locations. Kim Moses wrote an article in the Ocean Pines News Letter regarding properly disposing of trash and recyclables, and to discourage illegal dumping by both residents and visitors.
- **BUDGET** – Jessica Wilson handed out Budget Year 2020 Worksheet Reports. She went over the budget for Recycle and for the Homeowner Convenience Centers which is now General Fund. She also went over the budget for Solid Waste.
- **WORCESTER COUNTY RECYCLING** –Bob Keenen reported on the Town Hall Meeting given by Chip Bertino at the Ocean Pines Library. He and Mike McClung attended this meeting to give a presentation on Recycling. They played an interactive game of what is recyclable and what is not. The meeting went well and the public asked a lot of questions. They plan to do the same at the schools and also have tours again at the Recycling building.

- **CELL 5 UPDATE** – TJ Morris gave an update on Cell 5. 75% of the first half is fluff layer and about $\frac{1}{2}$ of the cell floor is now covered in fluff layer.
