Overview of the Comprehensive Plan





What is a Comprehensive Plan?

- Blueprint for the future: 20-year horizon
- Establishes a vision for growth, change and preservation for the next 20 years
- Guides decisions on land use, transportation, housing, economic development, environmental issues, and historic preservation
- Coordinates local planning efforts
- Fulfills State of Maryland requirements



What is a Comprehensive Plan?

- Main Components:
 - Identifying Needs and Opportunities
 - Supporting Goals and Recommendations
 - Guiding Future Development
 - Outlining Implementation
- Public Input:
 - Helps to prioritize needs and opportunities
 - Helps to establish community vision for growth and preservation
 - Helps to identify desired development patterns



What a Comprehensive Plan is NOT:

A comprehensive plan *is not*.

- A set of regulations
- An ordinance
- The same as the zoning code (zoning helps to implement the Plan)

- Provides overall "big picture" guidance for the entire Comprehensive Plan
- Is supported by all the goals and policies in the Comprehensive Plan
- Is often formatted as a short paragraph
