1.0 – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS	
The following questions and answers are provided as a matter of information to clarify issues raised about the Bid	
Documents.	
Item	Questions and Answers
1.1	Q. Will the stone adjacent to the bulkhead need to be boxed out and paved with base asphalt?A. Yes, remove 4 inches of stone, pave 2.5 inches of base and then 1.5 inches of surface asphalt to match the rest of the parking lot. A 12-inch perimeter of existing stone should be left around the bulkhead.
1.2	Q. Will the surface asphalt need to tie-in flush, or be held down at the timber bulkhead?A. We are not needing it to be flush with the top, contractor to leave a 12-inch perimeter of existing stone all the way around the bulkhead to allow water to penetrate through the weep holes.
1.3	Q. Is wedge and leveling required to insure positive drainage away from bulkhead?A. Wedge and leveling is required to ensure water drainage back to the bulkhead for water to penetrate back through the weep holes.
