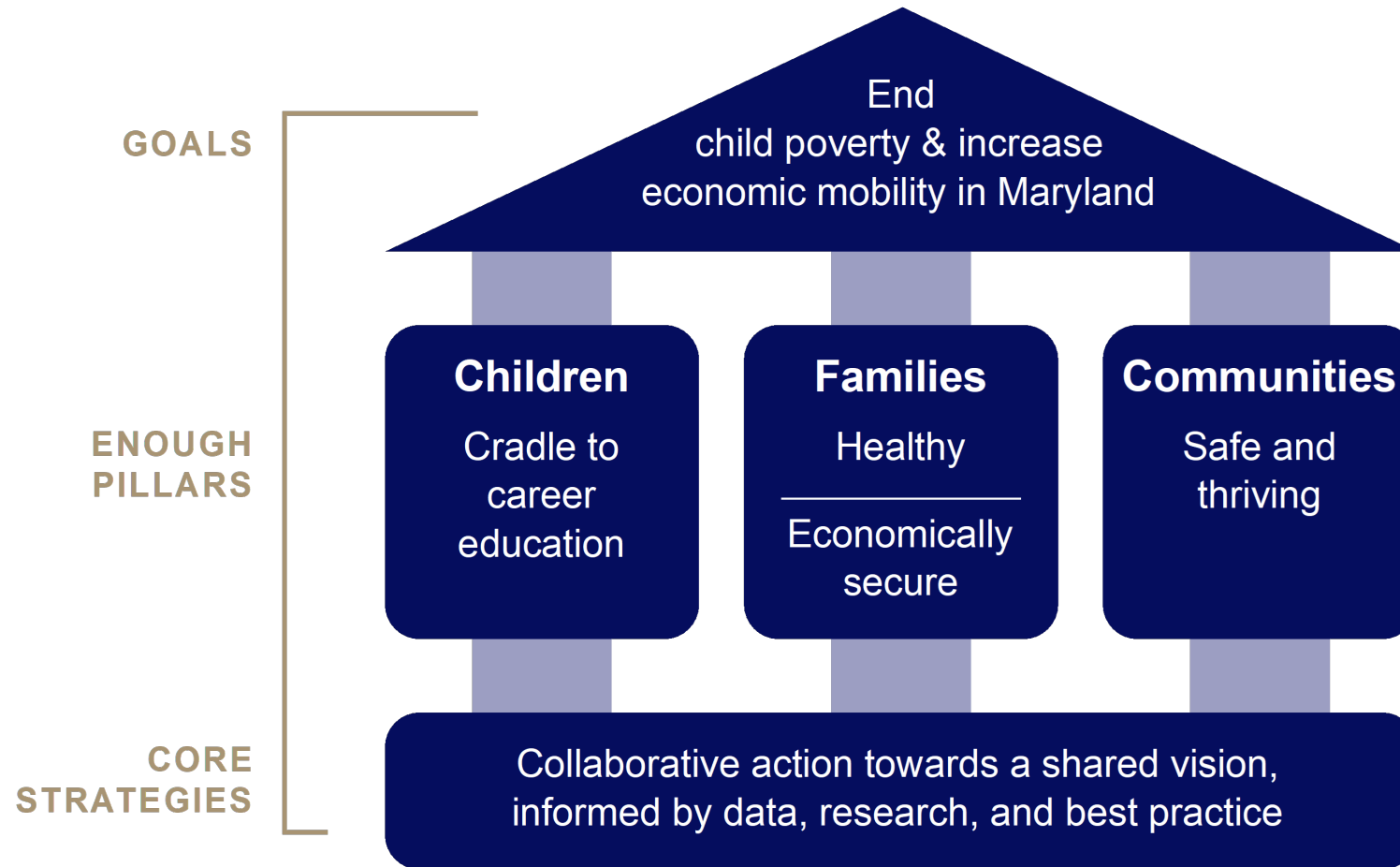

ENOUGH Act and the Worcester LMB

- Worcester LMB is a Capacity Grant Awardee, charged with building capacity in the county around the impacts of child poverty, assessing needs, and ultimately utilizing funding to begin challenge norms to traditional programs and services.

Needs Assessment

The LMB is seeking proposals from qualified agencies to conduct a comprehensive Needs Assessment focusing on childhood and generational poverty, cradle to career education, and services specific to addressing gaps in resources.

The LMB is seeking proposals from interested parties outlining a robust, succinct and concise Needs Assessment. Proposals should include:

- History of conducting Needs Assessments
- Evidence of succinctly packaging Needs Assessment data into a comprehensive overview
- A commitment to reaching community members with lived experience
- A detailed timeline
- A detailed budget not to exceed amount allotted: **\$100,000**

Project Specifics

The LMB reserves the right to negotiate the proposed timeline and budget.

The LMB will meet with the chosen vendor to finalize project plans, expectations, timelines, and specific areas of focus before a contract is signed.
