- d. FY 25 Capital Projects
 - i. Replace Mixer for FET No. 1 delivered, coordinating installation
 - ii. Clarifier No. 1 bent rake arm under repair, discovered additional corrosion to baffle weir wall, Commissioners approved additional funding to repair \$61,113.67 on 5/6/25;
 - iii. Blower 5/6/25 Commissioners also approved additional funding to repair blower, original to plant, cost of \$27,732.97; Purchase order issued 6/5/25, 6-8 weeks to repair. Will add rotating replacement blowers to future budgets
 - iv. Clarifier & Blower repairs left the plant maintenance account depleted, Commissioners approved an additional ~\$20,000 funding through remainder of fiscal year
 - v. Treatment Unit No. 4 cleaning Awarded 5/6/25 to Miller Environmental Group, \$124,157.97; \$75,000 was budget, remaining funds were used from reserves; will add additional tank cleanings to future budgets

turned over to the County. Waiting for contractor to complete the punch list items for water and sewer utilities. The contractor is investigating infiltration on the sewer system during rain events.
