- Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP): MDE has recently announced that the new General Permit For Discharges from Stormwater Associated with Industrial Activities Maryland General Permit No. 20-SW will become effective February 1, 2023. The County will need to complete a Notice of Intent (NOI) application for coverage under the new permit (20-SW). The SWPPP accompanies the NOI. The NOI shall be submitted by July 31, 2023
- Langmaid Borrow Pit: received permit from MDE, dirt hauling contract awarded to Reese Transportation on 12/20/22 for \$92/load
- Cobalt Study MDE asking for continuous testing/monitoring, open to removing the requirement in the future

- Groundwater monitoring report submitted to MDE on 12/29/22
- Cell 5 Wetland Mitigation additional plantings completed on November 4, 2022. The year 3 monitoring report submitted to MDE on 12/16/22.
