

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**  
**WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATIONS BUILDING**  
**WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND**

The Worcester County Commissioners are currently accepting sealed bids for construction of a new single story 3,500 GSF Operations Building for the Ocean Pines Wastewater Treatment Plant for the Worcester County Department of Public Works – Water and Wastewater Division. The new building shall house a laboratory, offices, training room, breakroom, toilets, equipment storage and associated support spaces. The construction will consist of masonry load bearing exterior cavity walls, wood trusses, metal roof, windows and doors, drywall, steel stud partitions, acoustical ceilings, resilient flooring, painting, and MEP. Interested bidders are encouraged to attend a mandatory **Pre-Bid Conference at 2:00 PM (EDT) on Tuesday, November 24, 2020** at the Worcester County Department of Public Works – Ocean Pines Wastewater Treatment Plant at 1000 Shore Lane, Berlin, Maryland 21811. **Sealed proposals will be accepted until 1:00 PM (EDT) on Monday, December 21, 2020** in the Office of the County Commissioners of Worcester County at Room 1103 - Worcester County Government Center, One West Market Street, Snow Hill, Maryland 21863, at which time they will be opened and the results posted online shortly thereafter. Envelopes shall be marked "**Bid Enclosed – Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations Building**" in the lower left-hand corner. After opening, bids will be forwarded to the Public Works Department for tabulation, review and recommendation to the County Commissioners for their consideration at a future meeting. In awarding the bid, the Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids, waive formalities, informalities and technicalities therein, and to take whatever bid they determine to be in the best interest of the County considering lowest or best bid, quality of goods and work, time of delivery or completion, responsibility of bidders being considered, previous experience of bidders with County contracts, or any other factors they deem appropriate.
